

AN EVENING YESHIVAH

THERE WERE MANY JEWISH BOYS WHO HAVE RECEIVED A FUNDAMENTAL JEWISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION EITHER IN A YESHIVAH OR IN A TALMUD TORAH SCHOOL, BUT SOME OF THESE BOYS WERE COMPELLED, PROBABLY DUE TO PERSONAL FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES, TO GO TO WORK AT AN EARLY AGE, THEREFORE THEY WERE NOT ABLE TO CONTINUE TO RECEIVE AN ADVANCED JEWISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION AT A YESHIVAH OR TALMUD TORAH, DURING THE MORNING HOURS. IF THERE WOULD HAVE BEEN EVENING CLASSES IN SOME OF THE YESHIVAHS AND TALMUD TORAHS IN GREATER NEW YORK, WHERE A JEWISH RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION WOULD HAVE BEEN IN THE EVENING, THEN SOME OF THE BOYS WOULD HAVE SURELY ATTENDED SUCH CLASSES. BUT ALAS, THIS PHASE OF JEWISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION HAS BEEN MUCH NEGLECTED IN THE PAST FEW YEARS.
